Effective 1, July 2020 COVID-19 Booking Protocol

All rounds of Golf played by at Gerringong Golf Club during the COVID-19 pandemic must be pre-booked. This pre-booking is to ensure the safety of members, visitors and staff and to ensure all people who attend the course are listed in the day sheet in the event we are required to provide this information to the public health unit.

The following applies for bookings:

- All rounds MUST BE PRE-BOOKED.
- VISITORS ARE WELCOME
- **NO WALK UP STARTS**. You will be asked to immediately leave the course and car park and phone for a booking. This applies whether there is someone on the course or not.
- All players must be named as part of the booking.
- Each booking will be given a time, please arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before and be ready to play. **Tee times will be 8 minutes apart.**
- 4 people to a group, 2 people may share a cart.
- You must not attend the course if you have any cold or flu symptoms:
 - o Dry cough
 - o Fever
 - Chest Infection
 - Sore throat
 - Shortness of breath.
- If any of these are present you CANNOT ATTEND THE COURSE.
- Commencing 1/7/20 there will be more competitions each week, Sunday, Monday, Wednesday & Thursday with 1 prize pool for 4 days, Tuesdays and Saturdays and Ladies Thursdays.

 In the Sunday, Monday, Wednesday & Thursday competition, a player may as many times as they like, provided you are pre-booked and the \$15 competition fee is paid for each round. Where there is more than one entry, only the best score entry will be used for prize allocation however you will be handicapped for each round. This competition will be finalised Friday afternoon.

 A Saturday competition will also be held, and finalised Monday. Tuesday Competition will be finalised Wednesdays. There is no Friday competition at this stage.
- Please be aware there are modified rules for competitions including: You must mark your own card however verbal agree on the score of each hole and at the end of the round, sign and placing in the box provided.
- Please do not touch the flagstick, it has been modified with plastic conduit and foam below the hole surface. The ball must be in the hole to be considered "holed out"
- There are no rakes in bunkers but you may take a preferred lie in bunkers. Try and smooth the bunkers with your feet.
- Refer the notice board for other local rules.
- Please abide by the rules of social distancing.
